September 19th at 7pm: Learn about depth field (limited and extended) and aperture. Bring your camera to shoot depth field.

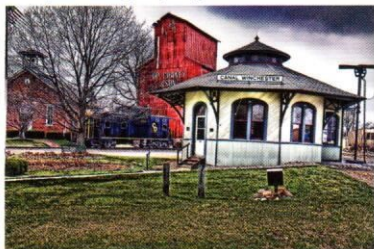
Week Three
